

Experience of Japanese Culture in Fudousan Seiryuji Temple

This temple opened in 1990 (Heisei 2). The site of about 30,000 tsubo is filled with Japanese gardens created by Buddhist monk. A lot of stones including 35 tons of rock and moss, and a stone lantern from hundreds of years ago are arranged. The flowers of the four seasons such as azaleas and weeping cherry trees decorate the garden. You can meditate on each of them in various halls, or you can transcribe shakyo in the sutra dojo. "Shuzen Dojo", a space where the mind is washed, practices the teachings of Sington Mikkyo. Why don't you spend some time in peace?

Timing of implementation

Reiwa October 1 (Sat) - March 31, Reiwa2 (Tue)

Daily with advance reservation

3 hours 00 minutes / time

Arrival and departure from the meeting place

You can change the departure time from 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. to /from Ibusuki Station.

Guide fee

2-3 people 9,500yen (tax included)/people

(taxi fee, guide fee, sutra experience, accident insurance)

4-8 people 8,000yen (tax included)/people

(taxi fee, guide fee, sutra experience, accident insurance)

9 people or more 5,500yen (tax included)/people

(Bus fee, guide fee, sutra experience, accident insurance)

2,000yen (tax included)/people (participants who come by bus, rental car, etc. Ibusuki station set)

Ibusuki Station (accompanied by a guide) ⇒ *Appreciation of flowers of Lake Ikeda four seasons ⇒

Seiryuji Temple ⇒ Walk in The Seiryuji Temple, Shakyo experience ⇒ Ibusuki Station dissolved
Flowers and trees vary depending on the season.

There is a time when there is no flower in Lake Ikeda because of the change of the flower planting.
